

Start	S.Anna di Roccabruna
Climb	225 m
Max. altitude	1.475 m
Walking time	2h30'

An easy hike for all, with a single climb from the climb to the Boscuola crossroad. At the foot of Monte Rocceré the forest road becomes a beautiful path that running along the Combal the Duc leads to the Rocca del Castlass, famous climbing wall controlled by the ruins of a medioeval tower. At the 3-roads crossroad we'll choose the one on the right, leading to Sant'Anna at the foot of Rocca Cubiera. Many point of interests along the hike: the Freedom Trails, remembering the resistance fighter that found shelter on these mountains in 1943-44, the Rocceré petroglyphs and the ancient pyrite mine.
