

ELVA A SPASS PER LOU VIOL

Start	Elva, Borgata Serre
Climb	300 m
Max. altitude	1.941 m
Walking time	2h45'

At the start, in Serra, the visit of the church with Hans Clemer's frescos and the museum "di Pels" (hair traders) have not to be missed. The hike goes initially among the larches, until Colle di San Giovanni, where wide views open on the Orrido and the Chersogno-Pelvo group. The San Giovanni chapel was a shelter point on the "Strada dei Cannoni", a military road built by the Piedmont army during the 1744 war, then refurbished by Napoleon. Once climbed a short gravel road, the trail crosses the basin of Elva, going back to Serre by the hamlet of Martini.
