

THE HAMLETS OF MARMORA

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| Start | Marmora / Canosio crossroad |
| Climb | 460 m |
| Max. altitude | 1.650 m |
| Walking time | 3h30' |

The hike runs on the sunny side of the valley, with great light and shadow contrasts. From the Marmora - Canosio crossroad we'll take the path along the hydropower plant, to reach Finello and San Sebastiano. The gravel road leads then to Torello and Garino, before climbing to Urzio, Arvaglia and Grange Giove, before descending to Sogna Rotonda and the church of San Massimo. We'll then go down to Reinero and Verneti, ner to the starting point. Marmora's hamlets are full of art and history: the San Sebastiano chapel, with Baleison's frescos, and the sundials in the walls of San Massimo. Some will notice the big stones used in the building of the upper villages, recovered from the collapse of the ancient church.
